

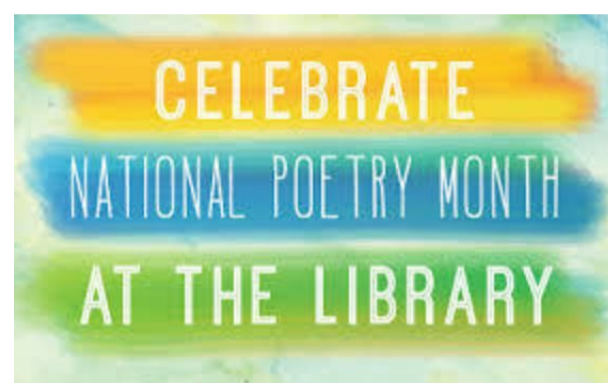

poetry
at the Chehalis Timberland Library.**



April is National Poetry Month. This program is an inspirational way to start.

As children, we are enchanted by the stories, humor, absurdity, and rhyming cadences of nursery rhymes. Sadly, the early joy of verse, chanted or sung, is often lost when poetry becomes hard work - overly examined, deconstructed and analyzed.

Poet and performer Judith Adams will help us rediscover the enchantment of poetry at the Vernetta Smith Chehalis Timberland Library, Saturday, April 1, 2-3 p.m.



Poet Judith Adams is a 2017 member of the Humanities Washington Speakers Bureau.

Adams will draw upon the works of other poets, including many from Washington State, to demonstrate how poetry can "radically enhance, change and even save our lives." She will explore the joy of reciting poetry, encourage guests to talk about their experiences with poetry, and lead exercises designed to fire up the poetic imagination.

Adams is an English-born poet who has lived in the United States since 1976. She has published four books of poetry and recorded several albums of her work. Her poems have been published in numerous magazines and anthologies.
