**The Bridge Music Project**

Headlining the evening is **Bridge Music Project**, a youth Hip Hop collective that writes, produces, and records original music that tells their stories. Based in Thurston County, the non-profit organization also performs throughout the community and has shared the stage with Grammy Winning artists including Kimya Dawson and Wanz (Singer of Macklemore's Thrift Shop). Over

three hundred youth have participated in the project since its inception in 2014, producing 37 songs.
