### As libraries evolve and change, TRL continues to increase access and serve more patrons with Books by Mail, New Hours, and Expanded Access Hours Locations!


Timberland Regional Library's **Books by Mail** recently expanded its parameters to provide library materials to patrons who cannot visit their library due to proximity to a library building, physical disability, or lack of transportation. <u>Visit our website to apply</u>!

Beginning July 1, our <u>Hawks Prairie</u> location will be open **7 days a week**, 10 a.m. – 6 p.m. Our most popular, in-demand books and DVDs are waiting to see if its your lucky day to skip the hold line.

Two more locations have added **Expanded Access Hours**: <u>Tenino</u> and <u>Ilwaco</u>. Expanded Access Hours are 7 days/week from 7 am until the library opens, and after the library closes until 8 pm. This services is for ages 14 and older and once approved, your access includes ALL EAH locations.





# 81 Year Overdue Book returned to the Aberdeen Timberland Library

The Aberdeen Library staff was amazed when the book, "The Bounty Trilogy" by Charles Nordhoff and James Norman Hall was returned to the library...81 years overdue.

The library book with an original due date of March 30, 1942, was recently found in a storage unit, and returned by a patron. The staff calculated that if overdue fines had accrued at the rate of \$.02/day, barring holidays and Sundays as it outlines on the original library card, the patron would owe about \$484.80.

However, since the library has eliminated overdue fines, if this patron were to have returned this book today, <u>no</u> <u>fines would be collected</u>!
