

Information Technology Security Policy

Purpose

To provide Information Technology Security controls for Timberland Regional Library (TRL) employees, as well as IT equipment, software, and services used by TRL.

Scope

Applies to all TRL employees, computing equipment, and software used by TRL.

Policy

The TRL Administration will create and maintain an Information Technology Security Procedure.

The Information Technology Security procedure will be reviewed annually by the Executive Director and the Information Technology staff.

The Information Technology Security Procedure will be based on industry best practices and recommendations from the State of Washington and NIST Special Publication 800-53.

IT staff will receive training on Information Technology Security and the controls identified in the Information Technology Security Procedure.

Definitions

Information Technology (IT): Any computer, phone, tablet, network device, application, or externally hosted software/service that TRL uses to conduct business is considered Information Technology.

Background

TRL relies on information systems to achieve its mission and provide services to its patrons. Information Security policies are designed to maintain the confidentiality, integrity, and availability of critical information services and data.
